




INTERNATIONAL SCRATCH OLYMPIADS 2026



EVENT ESSENTIALS & TIMELINE



DEADLINE: 31ST MAY 2026
All projects must be completed and submitted via the official registration portal by this final date.



THEME: SUPERHEROES FOR GOOD

Students must create projects where a superhero addresses real-world issues like environment, health, or community welfare.



US\$15 PARTICIPATION FEE

The fee includes registration, professional project evaluation, and an e-certificate of participation for every student.

THE 4-STEP PARTICIPATION PROCESS



STEP 1: BUILD ON MIT SCRATCH

Design your project as an individual (no teams allowed), test for bugs, and align it with the "superheroes for Good" theme.



STEP 2: REGISTER & SUBMIT

Complete the form at scratcholympiads.com, pay the fee, and upload your shared Scratch project link.



STEP 3: EXPERT EVALUATION

A panel of judges reviews projects; results are announced within 30 days of the deadline.



STEP 4: GLOBAL RECOGNITION

Certificates and trophies are delivered in participating schools within 3 months of the results.

AGE CATEGORIES & COMPLEXITY LEVELS



CATEGORY A (AGES 5-8)

Focuses on simple animations, basic motion, and sound with a focus on "Effort and Presentation."
Project Level: Simple Animation/Basic Game.

CATEGORY B (AGES 9-10)

Project Level: Interactive Game or Story.

CATEGORY C (AGES 11-12)

Expects multi-level games using variables, conditions, and multiple sprites to solve complex missions.
Project Level: Multi-level Game / Interactive Story.

CATEGORY D (AGES 13-14)

Project Level: Advanced Game / Simulation.

CATEGORY E (AGES 15-18)

High-level requirements including complex simulations, advanced logic systems, and optimization.
Project Level: Complex Simulation/Social Impact Model.

SCORING CRITERIA & WINNING AWARDS



SCORING RANGE: 1.00 TO 5.00 POINTS

Projects are graded on theme integration, animation quality, script:code simplicity, and overall functionality.



CODING LOGIC IS KEY

Points are gained for using advanced techniques like user-defined blocks, variables, and well-commented scripts.
