A global competition using MIT Scratch to inspire creativity, logic, and problem-solving.



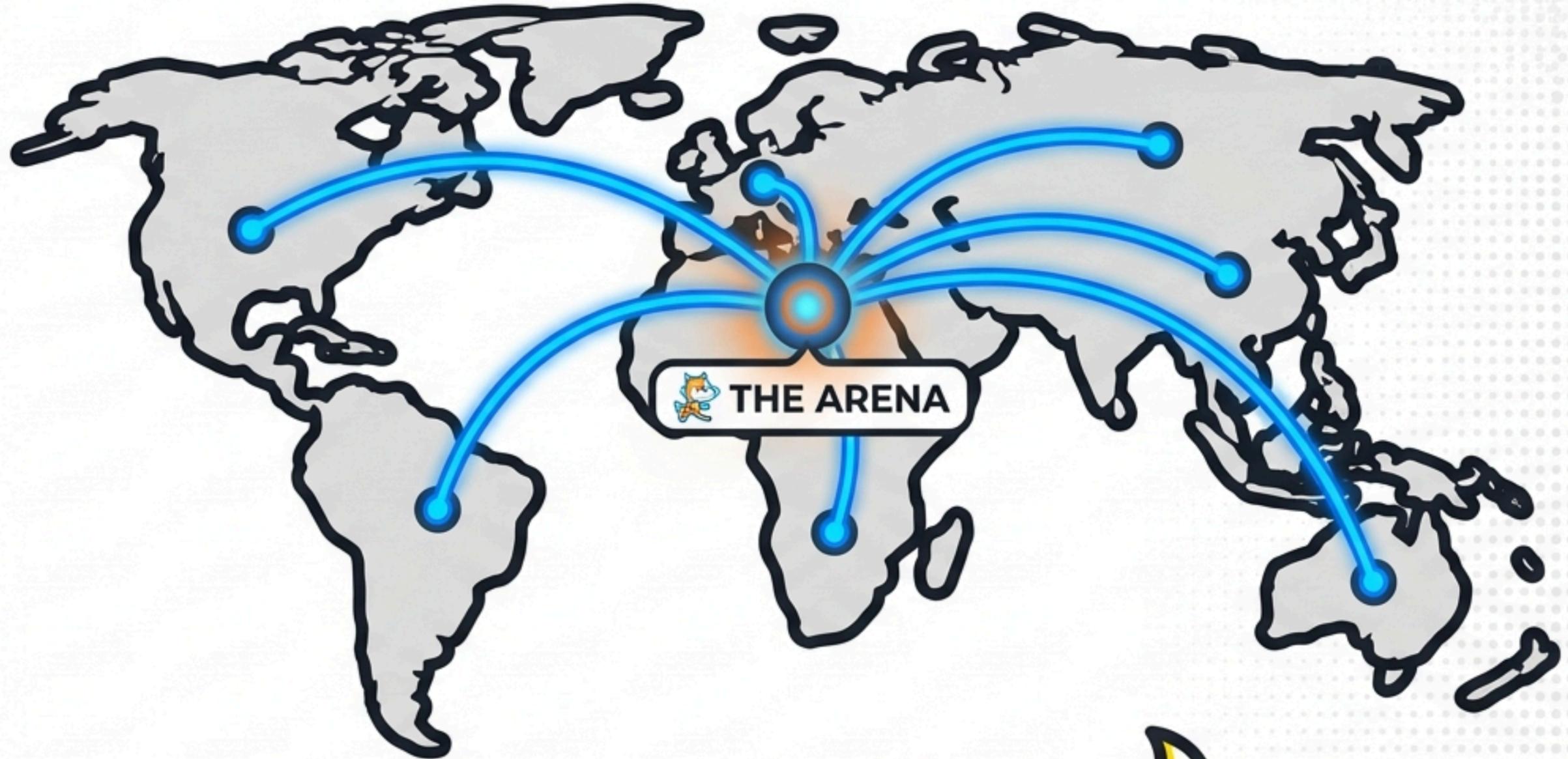
THE OBJECTIVE:

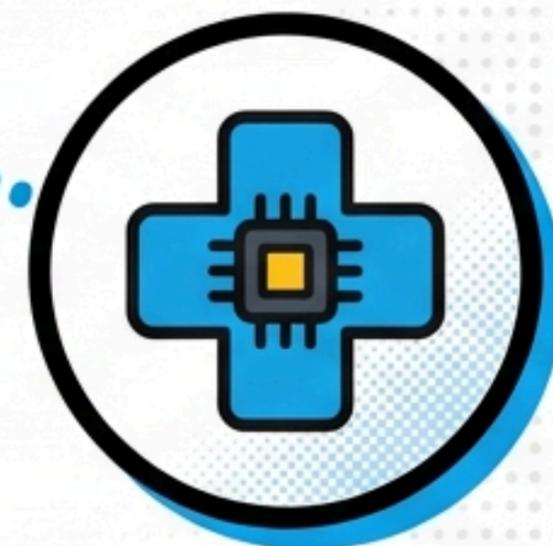

RESCUE QUEST

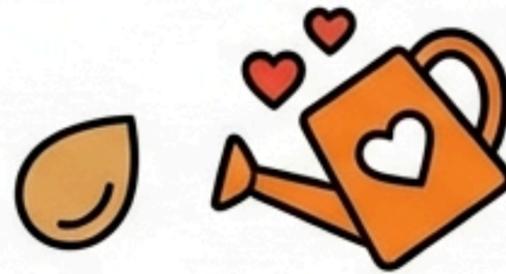


Mission: Save a baby animal or help a character jump obstacles.

Key Mechanic: Gravity & Movement.

Mission: A story of friendship where a seed grows only when 'watered' by kindness.

Key Mechanic: Variables & Costume Changes.

Mission: Clean the Ocean Game, Air Purifier Drone, or Recycle Right Quiz.

Key Mechanic: Collision Detection & Scoring.

Rule: Individual participation only. No teams. Category based on age at registration.

MISSION PARAMETERS: JUNIOR LEAGUE

CATEGORY A (5-8 YEARS)



- **Focus:** Simple Animation or Basic Game.
- **Specs:** Basic motion, sound, simple events.
- **Evaluation:** Creativity (30 pts) + Animation (20 pts).

CATEGORY B (9-10 YEARS)



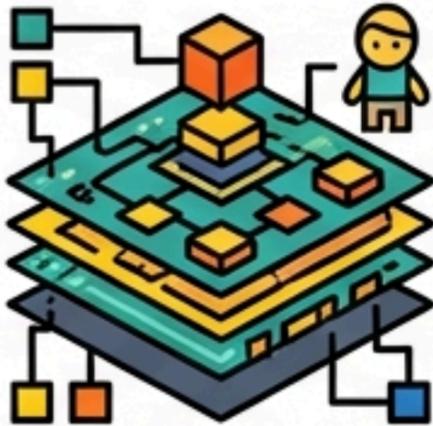
- **Focus:** Simple Interactive Game or Story.
- **Specs:** Events, loops, simple scoring variables.
- **Evaluation:** Coding Logic (25 pts) + Creativity (25 pts).

MISSION PARAMETERS: SENIOR LEAGUE

CATEGORY C (11–12)

Focus: Multi-level Game

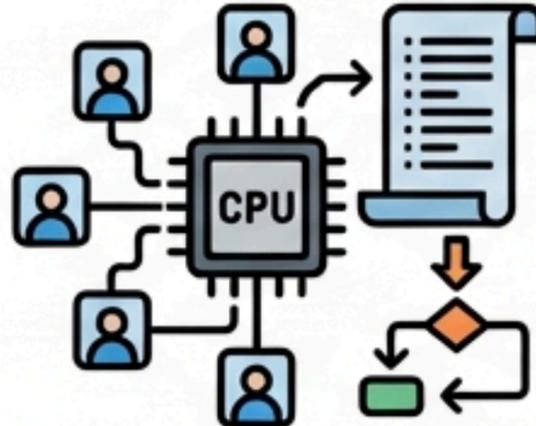
Specs: Variables, conditions, multiple sprites



CATEGORY D (13–14)

Focus: Advanced Simulation

Specs: Clones, lists (inventory), advanced logic



CATEGORY E (15–18)

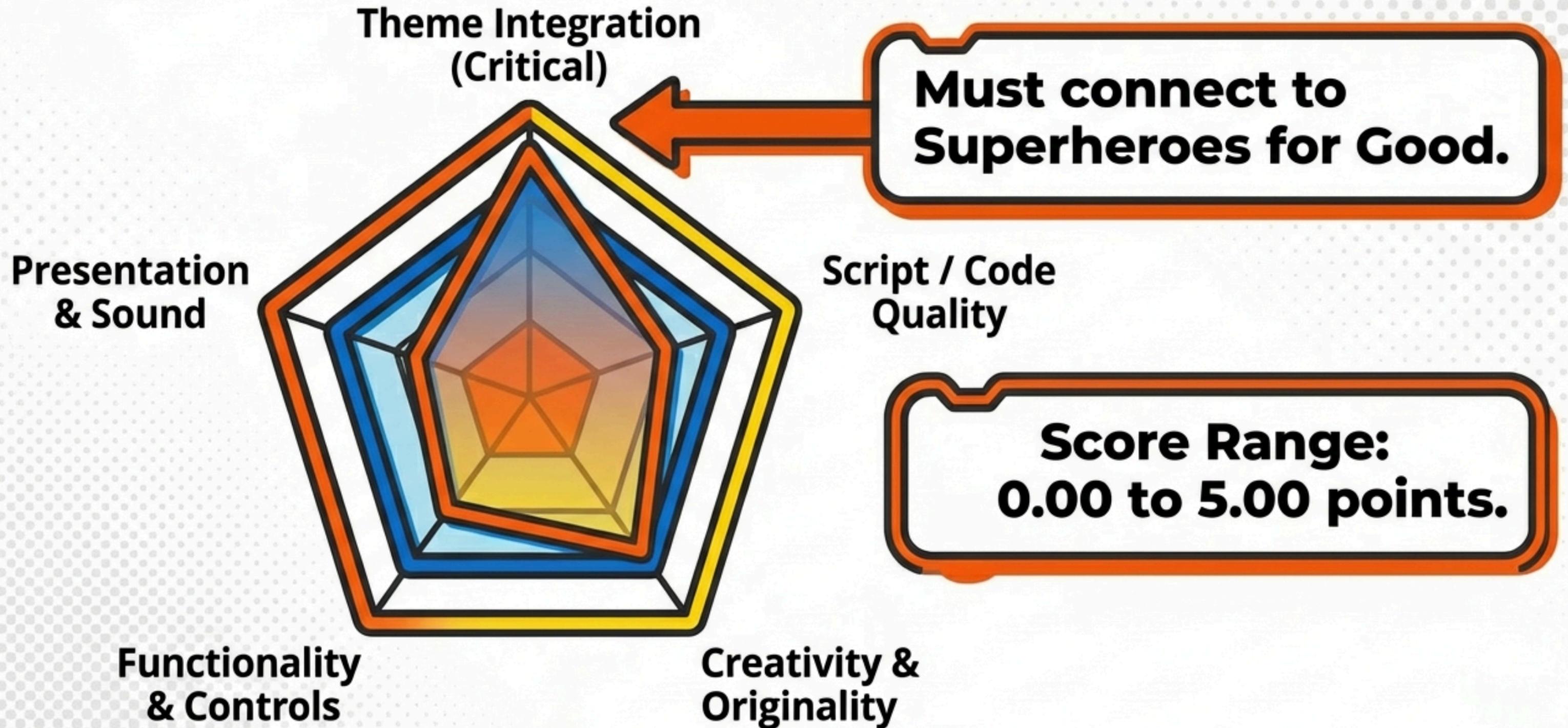
Focus: Social Impact Model

Specs: Multi-screens, optimization, realistic consequences



Key Differentiator: Real-World Relevance and Innovation.

THE DANGER ZONE: DISQUALIFICATION PROTOCOLS



Identity Fraud:

Adult help, false age, or team submissions.



Plagiarism:

Copying old projects, remixing existing work, or using widely known code.



Technical Errors:

Modifying after deadline, broken links, or inappropriate content.

project link.

Contact support for single payment link.

PRO-TIPS FOR AGENTS



DESIGN STRATEGY

Start simple (1-2 sprites) and expand later.



AUDIO INTEL

Use sounds to tell the story (failure cues vs success chimes).



CODE ETIQUETTE

Add comments to your scripts—judges love clarity.



COMPLIANCE

Ensure all assets are original or licensed. No broken links!

Partner with the League

Collaborate to empower students.

Bulk registration support ensures seamless entry for entire classrooms.

Host Events

Organize interactive workshops or global coding events.
